Request for Interest in Applying for the Anticipated CA HCD and Federal ESG NOFA

Available for Projects to Improve Housing and Quality of Life For the County Homeless

The Butte Countywide Homeless Continuum of Care (CoC) is soliciting interest from qualified agencies and organizations, in anticipation of the State Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) releasing the FY2018 NOFA for federal funds for the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program, and State funds for the California ESG Program (CA ESG) for eligible Continuum of Care (CoC) Service Areas.

The ESG Program provides funding to: (1) engage homeless individuals and families living on the street; (2) improve the number and quality of emergency shelters for homeless individuals and families; (3) help operate these shelters; (4) provide essential services to shelter residents; (5) rapidly re-house homeless individuals and families; and (6) prevent families/individuals from becoming homeless.

CoC jurisdiction of Chico/Paradise/Oroville/Butte County anticipates receiving approximately \$834,301 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG and CA ESG) funding for Fiscal Year 2018-2019. The CoC is responsible for the recommending applicants to HCD.
